Dear Mr. Lanier,

Recently Collis Roofing completed re-roofing of about 14 squares of flat roof on my Daughter's residence in Tampa. As you might of heard or not the job was very challenging due to several factors of note such as non code complying roof curbs for a package unit which was integrated into the curb for the supply and return ducts, non compliance of nail patterns and framing members, required reuse of two 4' X 6" skylights, rotted wood coupled with the travel distance required. But the greatest challenge was the number of roofing plys that had to be removed; in some cases it was 2 + inches.

Against that background, the tear off was anything but "ordinary" and as a Florida licensed general contractor (CBC 025147) I have had my own challenges constructing commercial buildings with many types of roofing systems and I am confident to say that without the supervision, direction and leadership of Gary Moser the nature of this letter might have had a different tone.


Gary was on the job/roof for most of the time (as was I) and provided sound judgment calls that was an excellent balance between the best interest of the client, Collis Roofing and best practices. He identified a quick and practical method to expedite the tear off by using sawsalls purchased on the spot and lots of blades to cut the membranes into manageable pieces and an assortment of other methods to achieve the goals.

It should be noted that at all times safety was observed and the one time I requested more tempered language from Jimmy's crew (skylights were open into the house) he immediately arranged a quick meeting, explained the protocol and the issue was a non issue. He kept us informed as to schedule and what and when to expect it, in short this was a small but complicated scheduling job that could have been a nightmare without a professional like Gary and Collis Roofing.

In today's economic climate it is gratifying to deal with a company such as Collis that doesn't cut corners, generate frivolous change orders and honors it contracts. I will not hesitate to recommend Collis to anyone inquiring for a roofing expert.
